

STRATEGY FOR TESTING

- Harmony Place has completed baseline testing of all residents and associates as of July 20, 2020.
- Harmony Place has access to COVID-19 diagnostic tests through Medical Diagnostic Laboratories for testing of all residents and staff.
- Harmony Place has access to COVID-19 diagnostic tests on-site that equal or exceed associate and resident total number.
- Harmony Place requires that all non-essential associates and volunteers receive testing based upon current OLTL guidance.
- Should a resident decline COVID-19 diagnostic testing, they will be treated as “presumed positive” and quarantined to their room.
- Should a staff member decline COVID-19 diagnostic testing, they will be removed from the schedule until such time as staff member undergoes testing and test results are received at the community.
- Residents who test positive for COVID-19 will be placed on isolation precautions and quarantined to their room.
- Staff who test positive for COVID-19 will be removed from the schedule and quarantined per the CDC, State and Local guidelines.

STRATEGY FOR SCREENING

- All staff members undergo temperature checks at the beginning and the end of their shift. Should a temperature read higher than 100.3, the associate is not to report for duty. Completion of screening questionnaire with signature to attestation is required for all staff.
- Vitals are taken daily for all current residents when building is COVID negative. Vitals are taken 3X daily for all current residents when building is COVID positive. All new residents shall show proof of one negative COVID-19 test as per CDC guidelines prior to admission.
- All visitors, volunteers, non-essential personnel, and compassionate caregivers undergo temperature checks upon entering the building. Should a temperature read higher than 100.3, the associate is not to report for duty. Completion of screening questionnaire with signature to attestation is required for all.

STRATEGY FOR PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT AND STAFFING

- Adequate PAR levels have been established for Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) based on current burn levels.
- Harmony Place is well staffed and associates have been cross-trained for non-clinical tasks such as housekeeping, dining, and maintenance.

STRATEGY FOR COMMUNAL DINING AND ACTIVITIES

- Communal dining may be conducted with adherence to current social distancing protocols and infection control procedures.
- Seating will be arranged at six foot intervals.
- In case of an outbreak, communal dining will be restricted. In-room meal service will be provided for residents.

- Communal activities may be conducted with adherence to current social distancing, hand hygiene, universal masking guidelines, and infection control procedures inclusive of the below OLTL guidelines:
 - In Step 1, groups are limited to 5 or less residents at a time.
 - In Step 2, groups are limited to 10 or less residents at a time.
 - In Step 3, groups will gather allowing for 6 feet social distance between residents.
- In case of an outbreak, communal activities will be restricted. If the outbreak is sustained for a period of two weeks or more, the facility will follow the OLTL Step 1 guidelines for resident emotional well-being.

STRATEGY FOR VISITATION

- Visitation hours are daily from 10A-11:30A and 1P-2:30P.
- All visits must be scheduled in advance by contacting the receptionist and will be prioritized based on health status of the resident and outside appointments that may limit resident availability.
- Visitation may be conducted with adherence to current social distancing, hand hygiene, universal masking, and infection control procedures inclusive of the below OLTL guidelines:
 - Step 1, visitation is restricted to virtual and window visits.
 - Step 2, visitation is restricted to those allowed in Step 1 and outside visits.
 - Step 3, visitation is allowed in neutral zone(s) not located in a resident care area within the community.
- Visitation areas will be disinfected using Virex, which is a CDC approved cleaning agent.
- No more than 2 visitors per resident will be permitted for outdoor and indoor visitation.
- All visits will be monitored by a Harmony Place staff member to ensure COVID-19 protocols are followed.
- In the event of severe weather, the visitation will be cancelled until the indoor visitation space is available.
- A table will be used to provide a six-foot social distance space.
